Insurance Requirement Checklist for IVIG

Getting your patients on to the therapies they need quickly and efficiently is our specialty. To help, we have put together a checklist to make sure you include everything needed to get your patient on to immunoglobulin (IG) therapy as quickly as possible.

Let's get started!

Step 1: Gather prescription and clinical documentation

Step 2: Fax signed prescription and clinical documents to **562.222.3320**. You can also ecribe prescriptions to California Specialty Pharmacy, NCPDP: 5638246, NPI: 1114239332.

Typical insurance requirements:

- ☐ Patient demographic information
- ☐ ICD-10 code (*make sure script and clinical notes have same code listed*)
- ☐ Copy of insurance card (*front and back*)
- ☐ Signed referral form and/or prescription
- ☐ Clinical notes (*2-3 most recent*)
- ☐ Any lab work pertaining to the diagnosis
- ☐ Documentation of tried and failed therapies



Additional disease-specific requirements that may be necessary:

Common variable immunodeficiency (CVID)

Typical ICD-10 codes:

D83.0, D83.1, D83.2 D83.8, D83.9

- ☐ Labs showing low IgG levels
- ☐ Vaccine challenge (most commonly pneumococcal)
 - ☐ Titers pre- and post-vaccine

Severe combined immunodeficiency (SCID)

Typical ICD-10 codes:

D81.0, D81.1, D81.2, D81.89, D81.9

- ☐ Labs showing low-to-absent IgG, and low IgA, IgM, and IgG subclass levels
- ☐ Labs showing low T-cells and/or documentation of low TRECs at birth

Non-familial hypogammaglobulinemia

ICD-10 code: D80.1

- ☐ Labs showing low IgG levels
- ☐ Vaccine challenge (most commonly pneumococcal)
 - ☐ Titers pre- and post-vaccine

Hereditary hypogammaglobulinemia

ICD-10 code: D80.0

- ☐ Blood work/testing (IgG levels should be lower than 200 mg/dL, low or absent B cells)

Selective IgG subclass deficiency

ICD-10 code: D80.3

- ☐ Labs showing normal total IgG levels
- ☐ Labs showing low IgG subclasses, excluding subclass 4
- ☐ Vaccine challenge (most commonly pneumococcal)
 - ☐ Titers pre- and post-vaccine

Selective IgA subclass deficiency

ICD-10 code: D80.2

- ☐ Labs showing normal total IgG levels
- ☐ Labs showing low IgA levels
- ☐ Vaccine challenge (most commonly pneumococcal)
 - ☐ Titers pre- and post-vaccine

Specific antibody deficiency (SAD)

ICD-10 code: D80.6

- ☐ Labs showing Ig levels, may or may not be low
- ☐ Vaccine challenge (most commonly pneumococcal)
 - ☐ Titers pre- and post-vaccine
