Insurance Requirement Checklist for IVIG

Typical insurance requirements:

	Patient demographic information
	ICD-10 code (make sure script and clinical notes have same code listed)
	Copy of insurance card (front and back)
	Signed referral form and/or prescription
	Clinical notes (2-3 most recent)
	Any lab work pertaining to the diagnosis
П	Documentation of tried and failed therapies



Additional diseasespecific requirements that may be necessary:

Myasthenia gravis (MG)

Typical ICD-10 codes: G70.01 G70.00 MG

If these labs are available, please send along with documentation:

- Positive antibody labs: AChR, MuSK, LRP4, Striational antibodies
- Single Fiber Electromyography (SFEMG) showing abnormal jitter
- Tensilon Test (edrophonium test)
- Chest CT (for thymoma)

Chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuritis (CIDP)

ICD-10 code: G61.81

If these labs are available, please send along with documentation:

- EMG/NCS (Electromyogram/Nerve Condition Study) with impression/ conclusion consistent with CIDP
- Lumbar puncture/spinal tap showing elevated CSF protein, negative VDRL
- Weakness in one or more limb

Multiple Sclerosis (MS)

ICD-10 code: G35.0

■ Documentation of 2-3 tried and failed therapies.
